The Center for Grief & Healing

The Center for Grief and Healing supported over 4,000 friends and neighbors just last year — with over 800 group counseling participants, 200 one-on-one counseling sessions, and nearly 180 group support sessions.

The Center for Children provides grief support through art and other expressive therapies to children and teens who have been affected by loss. Last year, over 1,200 total sessions were provided to bereaved children, often at their home or school, at no cost, thanks to private philanthropy.
